PLEASE READ Important information! Access to school Monday 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> May

The builders now plan to lay the ashphalt on the car park and the area to the front of school on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> May. While the ashphalt/tarmac is being laid and drying we will not be able to access the school through the main entrance or get to the rear playground from Haslingfield Road.

Mornings – the old front door by the little gate will be open between 8.45-9.55am if you arrive at this time. This is primarily to allow access for children travelling on the school bus. Outside this time you will need to come into school via the back gate from Heslerton Way.

**BUT note this gate** will be locked at 9.05am so please be prompt.

#### End of the school day – ALL children will need to be collected from the rear playground, accessed from Heslerton Way.

We cannot safely dimiss any children from the front of school due to heavy plant and machinery and the road. Please accept our apologies for the inconvenience. If you have any appointments during the school day please make arrangements with the office as to how to collect your child.
