During this term our topic is '**What lies beneath my feet?** Please select as many as you like, but we would suggest a minimum of two each half term. The homework exhibitions this term will be on Friday 15th February and 29th March.

1. Write about and draw your house and say which is your favourite part and why.
2. What is your favourite part of the village, why?
3. How has your local area changed, see if you can find old photos or talk to an older resident?
4. Draw and label your ideal school playground, what would you like to have in school?
5. Can you make a map of your route to school?
6. Go for a walk around the locality and record what you see.
7. Find out about LS Lowry then draw a picture in his style.
8. Make picture of a building and use as many different materials as possible
9. Create some animal word problems (e.g. if one pig has 4 legs, how many legs do 3 pigs have?)
10. Draw an underground habitat. Which animals live there?
11. Make a model of the Arctic or Antarctic.
12. Make a waterproof coat for one of the Three Little Pigs.

Year One Writing Targets:

Really Must– Consistently use capital letters at the beginning and full stops at the end of a sentence. Leave finger spaces between words.

Must– Use a capital letter for 'I' and proper nouns (names of places or people).

Should– Try to spell words phonetically. Use a question mark after a question and an exclamation mark in their writing.

Could – Use a connective other than 'and' to join sentences together. Use time connectives to move their writing on e.g. next, then, after that, first. Use a comma to demarcate a list.
