Create a map of London in 1666 showing the location of the River Thames, Pudding Lane bakery, Samuel Pepys house and where the fire spread.	Imagine you are Samuel Pepys and write 5 diary entries about what happened (what can you hear/see/smell/think/feel/say).	Using your knowledge of fractions to cut/share your dough or pizza into enough equal pieces for all your family - you could take photos or draw pictures,	Design and build a house from the time of the Great Fire of London out of the best/least flammable materials and explain why you made those choices.
Make a musical instrument out of recycled material.	Find out about one of the fossils found in Barrington - include pictures as well.	Write a Great Fire of London adventure!	Try baking like Thomas Fariner. Bring in some photos to show what you made.
Find pictures/information of Barrington; one from 1600s and one from now and compare what is the same and what's different.	Research what London was like in 1666 - you could make a presentation using powerpoint.	Use different bits of paper, card, material etc. to create a collage of a picture about the Great Fire of London.	Research and find out about Samuel Pepys or Christopher Wren. Draw a picture of them and include at least 4 facts.
Create a poster for being safe around fires - you could use labels, captions and pictures.	Draw a map and using compass directions, provide a route from one part of London to another.	Write and illustrate a poem about the Great Fire of London. Can you make it rhyme?	Paint a picture of one of the 4 Houses at school fossils (Ammonites, Brachiopods, Belemnites, Nautilus)
