Your child will get an unauthorised absence even if they have 'Late' marks. Where children arrive after the register has been taken ie the register has 'closed'; they are given Code 'U' which is then taken as an absence. (If they are only a little late, eg while the register is taken it will code 'L' and not recorded as an absence.
