#### **Sports Day - Update**

We are very aware that parents like to attend this event, but as of now, it is unlikely that parents will be invited. The advice from County still states avoiding events allowing visitors on to school site.

After the briefing next week we should be able to make a final decision. Sports day event is usually in the afternoon, but during very hot weather it could be held in the morning when it is cooler. In the event of rain, it would be postponed to the Friday 25th. Many apologies but the safety of our children and families and keeping school open to the end of term are our main priority.

**Thurs 24<sup>th</sup> June -** The reserve date, if the weather is bad will be Fri 25<sup>th</sup> June.

#### **COVID** restrictions

Keeping current restrictions in place focus must be on keeping the school open for all children. If we relax restrictions and enable the classes to mix freely, one positive case in school would mean all the children back on home learning while we self-isolate to stop the spread. Maintaining classes as separate groups would mean just one class would need to self-isolate enabling more children to stay in school. Since Melbourn Village College have had to close a bubble this week due to a positive case we need to do everything we can to ensure that we are able to stay open and that any closures can be limited to single bubbles.
